Program

You can help us support children by donating your old cell phones, pagers, PDA's, cameras, toner and inkjet cartridges which can be recycled to raise funds we use to provide additional services to the children we serve. Your support will mean we can make more educational materials available to children who are coping with difficult situations. Many of the children we serve are from families that are struggling with financial, legal and other serious challenges that often have a negative affect on child development. School supplies and mentoring supplies such as journals, workbooks and reading materials are valuable tools for these young children. Some phones collected can be turned into 911 phones for seniors, domestic violence victims or other people who are at risk. These phones are programmed to connect only with 911 emergency services and do not require cell phone service set-up fees or other user fees.

Drop boxes are located outside our office so you can drop off equipment anytime of the day or night. If you want a donation receipt you can stop by during the day and our receptionist can give you a receipt. We are located just west of Florida Avenue on Bearss Avenue.
